LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT, 1933

TO THE BULLINGDON RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL
THE PARISH COUNCIL OF MARSTON
AND TO ALL OTHERS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 50(1) of the Local Government Act, 1933, as amended by Section 12 of the Parish Councils Act, 1957, that the number of Parish Councillors for a Rural Parish shall be such number, not being less than five nor more than twenty-one, as may be fixed from time to time by the County Council

AND WHEREAS by an Order made by the Oxfordshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the County Council") dated the 10th May, 1939, the number of Parish Councillors to be elected for the Rural Parish of Marston (hereinafter referred to as "the Rural Parish") in the Bullingdon Rural District was fixed at nine

AND WHEREAS it has been represented to the County Council that in consequence of an increase in the population of the Rural Parish it is expedient that the number of Parish Councillors to be elected for the Rural Parish should be increased

NOW IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the County Council that the number of Parish Councillors to be elected for the Rural Parish shall be increased from nine to twelve

AND IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that an election be held of the three additional Parish Councillors at the next ordinary day of election of the Parish Councillors for the Rural Parish
