TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES

LOCATION: Marston, B4495 Marston Ferry Road / Cherwell Drive (junction of A4165 Banbury Road to the junction with B4150 Marsh Lane)

REASON: To facilitate installation of new road layout including traffic signs, traffic islands and carriageway surfacing

DURATION: Starting on 22 September 2025
The anticipated completion date is 27 September 2025 (date included). This will operate between 19:30 and 06:00

(Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5 consecutive days.)

ACCESS: Limited access will be maintained for emergency service vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of road, subject to the progress of the works. Access will be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE: via B4150 Marsh Lane – A40 Northern Bypass Road – A4165 Banbury Road and vice versa
