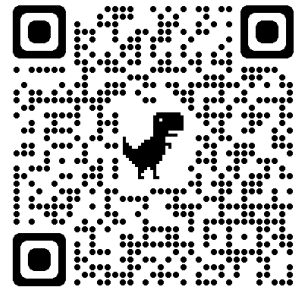
**The Oxfordshire County Council,
Old Marston Footpath No. 10 (part),
Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2023**

The Order made on 30 October 2023, if confirmed as made, will modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by diverting: -

Old Marston FP10 running from OS Grid Ref SP 5181 0774 southwards for 66m to SP 5181 0767 **to** a new line running from OS Grid Ref SP 5181 0774 south-eastwards for 30m to SP 5182 0771, southwards for 18m to SP 5182 0769, and south-westwards for 28m to SP 5181 0767, as shown on the Order map.
