Accessibility

Old Marston Parish Council is committed to providing an accessible website that is easy to use by anyone, whatever their age, background, access device or level of ability/disability.

Accessibility Standards and this Website

Old Marston Parish Council is continuously improving this website to ensure that it meets the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines issued by the Web Accessibility Initiative (WAI). The WAI website content accessibility guidelines (WCAG 2.1), published in 2018 by the World Wide Web Consortium (W3C), are the globally used and accepted standard for website accessibility, by both the corporate and public sector.

At present Old Marston Parish Council meets most of the criteria for level “AA” of the [WAI](#) guidelines, and work is being done to meet the full criteria.

Accessibility Help - Change the way this website looks - Using tools on your computer

You can control the look and functionality of this website, depending on your computer settings. Most computers will have accessibility settings you can change including; the way the screen looks (e.g. changing' fonts, sizes, colours, etc), the way the keyboard or mouse works and possibly speaking and listening to commands as well as a range of other features.

As several organisations have already produced lots of good content about how to make computers and websites more accessible, links have been made to these sites rather than duplicating their contents.
