An issue raised shall not require a response at the meeting nor start a debate. The Chairman may direct that an oral or written response be given (S.O. 3h) or that a note be made for later action.

A record of public participation may be included in the Minutes and if any actions are required they will be reported on at the next meeting.

 - h. Two fault codes on the fire alarm in the away changing rooms,**
 - i. Defibrillator: MSFC are willing to buy a defibrillator and are asking for permission to install on outside of new pavilion,**
 - j. Flooding area outside of double doors: MSFC are asking if they can install a drain away so as to stop flooding,**
