Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for Oxfordshire, 21 February 2006

I have pleasure in enclosing a copy of the new Definitive Map & Statement of Public Rights of Way for your parish.

This is the up-to-date legal record of public paths. Its relevant or *legal* date is 21 February 2006 and it replaces the previous edition dated 1st May 1999. **Please refer to this new Definitive Map & Statement when considering any local issues involving public rights of way.** If any changes occur to the Definitive Map & Statement, we will send you copies of legal orders relevant to your parish, which should be kept together with the Definitive Map & Statement.

This is a public document and should be available for inspection locally. The map is subject to Ordnance Survey copyright.

I should point out that on 2 May 2006 the re-designation of Roads Used as a Public Path (RUPPs) under the Countryside & Rights of Way Act 2000 took place. All RUPPs shown on the Definitive Map & Statement have now been re-designated as Restricted Byways.

The four types of recorded rights of way are therefore as follows:

Footpath	A highway over which the public have a right on foot only, other than such a highway at the side of a public road.
Bridleway	A highway over which the public have a right of way on foot and a right of way on horseback or leading a horse, with or without a right to drive animals of any description along the highway.

Restricted Byway	A highway over which the public have a right of way on foot, on horseback or leading a horse and for vehicles other than mechanically propelled vehicles.
Byway Open to all Traffic	A highway over which the public have a right of way for vehicular and all other kinds of traffic, but which is used mainly for the purpose for which footpaths and bridleways are so used.

I hope you find the new Definitive Map & Statement useful. If you have queries regarding any of the above information please do not hesitate to contact me on the above telephone number, or at the above address. Please note, however, that any problems with the network on the ground (e.g. obstructions, re-instatement of cross-field paths) should continue to be reported to the Field Officer for your area - tel: 01865 810226; email: countryside@oxfordshire.gov.uk
