## TRAFFIC REGULATION NOTICE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT, 1984

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, that the Oxfordshire County Council

**TEMPORARILY PROHIBITS THE USE OF AND WAITING ON THE HIGHWAY  
BY ALL MOTOR VEHICLES**

- LOCATION:** Cutteslowe, A40 Northern Bypass (Eastbound)  
(between the Banbury Road / Cutteslowe Roundabout  
and the B4150 Marston Interchange)
- REASON:** To facilitate the resurfacing of the carriageway and the  
subsequent reinstatement of all road markings and  
lines.
- DURATION:** Starting on 12 July 2024  
The anticipated completion date is 13 July 2024 (date  
included). This will operate between 20:00 and 06:00  
  
( Traffic Regulation Notices cover a maximum of 5  
consecutive days.)
- ACCESS:** Limited access will be maintained for emergency service  
vehicles and for frontages within the closed section of  
road, subject to the progress of the works

The “No Waiting” restriction means that wherever there are in place yellow “No Waiting” cones, you will not be able to park vehicles on the highway.

**SUGGESTED ALTERNATIVE ROUTE:** via A40 Eastbound from Cutteslowe  
will be diverted back along the A40 to Wolvercote  
Roundabout, to turn north up the A44 to Peartree  
Interchange, to turn south onto the A34 Trunk Road to  
Hinksey Hill Interchange, to use the A423 Southern  
Bypass and the A4142 Eastern Bypass to Headington, to

**turn back along the A40 Northern bypass returning to  
Marston.**
