

This is the opportunity for every resident in Old Marston Parish to make your views known to the Parish Council.

Old Marston Parish Council is aware that there have been issues regarding parking in various hot spots throughout the parish.

Although the county council has limited funds, the Parish Council will be lobbying them to take some action where it is needed in the parish and would like to know what Parishioners want. Please take a look at the choices below and contact the Parish Council with your views.

The council have informed us of what the various options are for restricting parking in the parish. For your information, these are:

- **Do Nothing**

- **Residents pay for a white access protection.**

This is not legally enforceable;

It can only be put in if the resident already has a dropped kerb. It costs about £50, and the paint lasts about 5 years. Residents can pay for a dropped kerb, which costs about £800 - £900 for one person, the price drops if the council installs more than one at a particular location (so if neighbours get together the cost per household is less)

- **Disabled parking**

This isn't person or property specific, but only blue badge holders can park there. This is legally enforceable and is free on request and meeting criteria on a case-by-case basis.

- **Restrictions**

Ideally, the County like to put standard restrictions as these are most easily understood. But can be bans for parking one hour per day, 1 on one side of the road and another time on the other, etc; could be a daytime only restriction (say, 8/6 Monday to Friday or Saturday)

- **Double yellow**

No parking 24/7 (although blue badge holders are allowed an exemption for 3 hours).

- **Limited Waiting**

This is as they have recently put in at Mortimer Drive and Rippington Drive.

- **Residents Parking**

This is as they have put in throughout New Marston. It costs residents around £50 per car. It is expensive for the county to install (not the lines and signs, that's the cheap bit. It's the consultation that costs. The bigger the area, the more consultation work is required).
