PARAGRAPH 2 OF SCHEDULE 2 TO THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT 1984

BT is seeking your permission to place/retain its apparatus on your land by asking you to sign and return the enclosed agreement form.

In doing so BT is seeking the right to

- enter your land to inspect that apparatus
- keep that apparatus installed on, under or over your land
- carry out any work on your land for or in connection with the installation, maintenance, adjustment, repair or alteration of the named telecommunication apparatus.

We appreciate that the siting of apparatus could be inconvenient and will endeavour wherever possible to locate our apparatus in a mutually acceptable position.

BT will do as little damage as possible in the installation and maintenance of the apparatus and will make good to your reasonable satisfaction any damage to your land.

If you decide to alter or improve your land with the result that our apparatus would need to be removed or altered, you may do so by giving BT notice in writing that you require the apparatus removed or altered as appropriate.

Payment Criteria

- Wayleave payments will not be made retrospectively and all payments will apply from the date of the application.
- Payments will not be made for apparatus which is being used to provide telecommunication services for the Grantor themselves or their own tenants exclusively.
- One Wayleave payment only is made for each item of apparatus (where applicable) and this will
 usually be made to the Freeholder of the land or property whether or not they occupy the property.
- Apparatus installed on new developments prior to occupation will not attract Wayleave payments.
- Wayleave payments may be agreed as an annual payment rather than a lump sum.
- Agricultural compensation payment (where applicable) will be made to the occupier or user of the
 land only, except where agreed otherwise with the Freeholder of that land. Where the occupier or
 user of the land is also the Freeholder both Lump sum Wayleave and Annual Agricultural
 compensation payments may apply.
- Agricultural compensation may be paid as a lump sum which will be 15 times the annual rate.

WAYLEAVE AGREEMENT FOR British Telecommunications plc TELECOMMUNICATION APPARATUS ON PRIVATE LAND

- 1.1 BT executing any works for or in connection with the installation maintenance adjustment repair alteration and inspection and to keep the above mentioned Telecommunications Apparatus on under or over the Grantor's land for the statutory purposes.
- 1.2 (where this Agreement relates to underground apparatus) BT installing and keeping therein such further Telecommunication Apparatus as BT sees fit.
- 1.3 BT by its officers, servants, agents or contractors with or without materials appliances vehicles and things from time to time and at all times hereafter entering and being upon the Grantor's land to exercise the rights and powers conferred by this Agreement and by the Telecommunications Code and for any purpose connected therewith.

2. **DEFINITION**

In this agreement where the context so admits

- 2.1 "BT" includes not only British Telecommunications plc but also its successors and assigns.
- "Grantor" includes not only the person named as Grantor but also all classes of persons bound by this Agreement having regard to the material provisions in the Telecommunications Code.
- 2.3 "Grantor's land" means the land shown on the annexed plan of which the Grantor is the occupier on, over or under which the Telecommunication Apparatus is to be
- 2.4 The following expressions have the same meaning as appears in the Telecommunications Code:

"the statutory purposes"

"structure"

"telecommunication apparatus"

References to "the Telecommunications Code" are references to those provisions in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 as have been applied to BT and apply to the telecommunication apparatus the subject of this agreement.

3. TERMINATION

This Agreement can be terminated in accordance with paragraph 20 of the Telecommunications Code by the Grantor and by the giving of 6 months notice by BT.

4. MAKING GOOD DAMAGE

BT will do as little damage as possible in the exercise of these rights and shall make good to the reasonable satisfaction of the Grantor any damage caused to the Grantor's land.

5. ACCESS TO APPARATUS

- 5.1 The Grantor's land shall not be used in such a way as to make the telecommunication apparatus difficult to access and, in particular, no structure, building or other erection and no tree or shrub the roots of which are likely to interfere with the telecommunication apparatus shall be placed or planted over the same or any part thereof, provided that no liability for breach of this Clause shall arise if the breach is necessary to comply with any statutory planning requirement as regards the planting of trees or shrubs.
 - 5.2 The Grantor shall not be liable for any breach of this condition after the Grantor has ceased to have any interest in the relevant portion of the Grantor's land.

6. INDEMNITY

BT shall indemnify the Grantor against liability for all third party claims costs proceedings and damages arising out of the exercise by BT of the said rights save to the extent that an act or omission by the Grantor or a person for whom the Grantor is responsible has caused or contributed to such claims costs proceedings and damages. Provided that the Grantor shall forthwith give written notice to BT of all such claims costs proceedings and damages being brought made or lodged against the Grantor in respect of the exercise of the said rights and shall not admit liability or settle such claims costs proceedings and damages or make any payment on account of the same without the written consent of BT except under a court of competent jurisdiction.

7. NOTICES

The provision of the Telecommunications Code as to service of notices shall apply to any notice required to be given hereunder and the proper address of the Grantor for such purposes shall be the Grantor's address as appears in this Agreement or subsequently notified in writing to BT and the proper address of BT for such purposes shall be the office address as shown on the bottom of this agreement or to its last known address as notified to the Grantor.
