

Charles Henry Webb

The family history of Bombardier "Charles Henry Webb" who lived at 47 Oxford Road, Old Marston, Oxford and who died on the 6th February 1917 in the great war of 1914-1918 and is buried at Lijessenthoek war cemetery in Belgium.

Commemorated on the memorial plaque at St. Nickolas church, Old Marston along with two nephews namely :- Henry George Ward (died 23.07.16-aged 17) and Ernest Alfred Ward (died 21.3.18-aged 21). These two brothers were from the family side of "Amelia Ann" the wife of "Charles Henry". The two boys' parents were Henry George and Emily Ward.

THE HISTORY

Richard Webb:- Born in "Great Rollright" - Oxfordshire in 1723. Married "Elizabeth Gubbins" on 12th October 1748. Had eight children including "Jeremiah".

Jerimiah Webb:- Born in "Great Rollright"- Oxfordshire on 27th June 1756 and died in 1822. Married twice and when widowed married "Hannah Baylis" at Hailey on 9th April 1796. Had six children by Hannah including "Emanuel" born on the 9th February 1812.

Emanuel:- Born in "Stonesfield"- Oxfordshire in 1812. Married to "Ann Andrews". Their son "Arthur" was born in 1841.

Arthur Webb:- Born in "Stonesfield"- Oxfordshire on 7th May 1841. Was attending Cowley school in Oxford at the age of 10 years. The family lived at 198 Little Brewery Street in St. Clements Oxford. Married "Jemima Trinder" from Headington on the 24th December 1865 when he lived in Jericho- Oxford. At the 1881 census they lived in Marston Road and had five children including "Charles Henry" aged 13 years. Arthur died in 1882.

Charles Henry:- Born in "St. Clements", Oxford at 198 Little Brewery Street in 1867. Married "Amelia Ann Ward" (born 1865) on the 30th October 1893. Lived in Old Marston, Oxford and had six children :-

Charles Henry (1894) ----- Eugene Arthur (1896)
George Albert (1898) ----- William Colenso (1900)
Eessie Verna (1903) ----- Elsie May (1907)

"Charles Henry" (1867) was my grandfather who joined the army towards the end of the first World War when he was aged about "fifty" but died of wounds on the 6th February 1917 and is buried at "Lijessenthoek" in Belgium.

Eugene Arthur :- (my father) Married "Carrie Edwards" in Neath S. Wales on the 20th August 1917 and had six sons.
